**Breeders Class** Stud Dog and two or more of his progeny or a brood bitch and two or more of her progeny. All dogs must be entered in one of the official classes but need not be owned by the same person. Trophy to go to the owner of the sire or dam.

**Kennel Class** 3 or more related or non-related progeny bred by the same kennel

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show/Test/Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event that will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the Closing Date.
3. The NSGSDC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
4. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
5. Entries will be refunded where Bitches are unable to compete in Obedience due to heats. Veterinary certificate must be provided to the Trial Secretary in order to apply for refund.
6. Judging schedules are broken down and based on 20-25 dogs per hour in conformation, 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour, and 5 Utility dogs per hour. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. There will be no waiting for dogs.
7. **All exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling.**
8. The precincts of the show and trial will extend 10' beyond the rings.
9. A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
10. No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

### Champions and championship points - chapter 15

**Section 1** - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:
